You may have noticed some changes to the school—the buildings are being painted,


there will be repair work on the mobiles and there is now CCTV in operation around the school.

The SNAG team (School Nutrition Action Group): Landhead Primary School actively promotes healthy eating. Pupils form a group of superheroes, who figure out the


